### Reservation Form

All groups applying for the use of the campground must send their reservation fee and a reservation form to the caretaker no later than May 1. The reservation fee is based on the largest number of daily campers in your group even if they do not spend the night.

Groups of 10 or less	\$100.00 per day
Groups of 11-20	. \$200.00 per day
Groups of 21-30	\$300.00 per day
Groups of 31-40	\$400.00 per day
Groups of 41-50	\$500.00 per day
Groups of 51-60	\$600.00 per day
Group of more than 60	\$700.00 per day

A damage deposit (\$100.00 for groups up to 25 and \$250.00 for groups of 26 and above) will be required at the beginning of your stay. Your deposit will be returned at the end of your stay. Any donations in addition to these fees will be very much appreciated. All registration fees and donations are used for the continual maintenance and improvement of the campground.

The applicant must meet with the caretaker for a walkthrough inspection upon arrival and before departure. The "Campground Cleaning List" will be used as a guideline for these walkthroughs. Damages found after your group's use of the campground will be noted and will help to determine the amount of the deposit to be refunded.

We appreciate your help as we continue the day-to-day operation of this facility so as to provide a pleasant experience for all involved.
