Campground Cleaning List

In order to keep the campground clean and in good repair, please meet with the caretaker to inspect the buildings and campground upon arrival and again before departure. This checklist will be used for those inspections. Any damages found after your group's use of the camp, will determine the amount of your damage deposit refund.

- 1. Clean all toilets, urinals and lavatories including lids, rims and bowls.
- 2. Sweep the floor in the dormitories.
- 3. Sweep and wet mop kitchen, dining room and bathroom floors. Please sweep floor before mopping.
- 4. Clean spills and spatters in and on convection ovens, stovetops, ovens and microwaves.
- 5. Clean countertops and tables with soapy water. Rinse with clean hot water.
- 6. Clean refrigerators and freezers that you use.
- 7. Clean kitchen sinks and remove food residue.
- 8. Remove trash and garbage from buildings on a daily basis and place outside the kitchen door. The caretaker will pick up the trash each day after the evening meal. Before departing, remove all trash bags even if they are only partially full.
- 9. Put back toys, puzzles, games, balls and outdoor recreational equipment.
