Guidelines for Campground Use

The Long Lake Bible Camp was built to provide a place to enjoy God's creation and a place where His people can gather for worship, study and recreation. Activities at the campground are to be consistent with the following guidelines.

- 1. Priority for use of the campground will be in the following order:
 - a. Activities sponsored by the Minnesota State Conference
 - b. Activities sponsored by churches within the Minnesota State Conference
 - c. Activities sponsored by churches within the Church of God denomination
 - d. Individuals or groups who are active members of a church within the Minnesota State Conference
 - e. Individuals or groups who are active members of a church within the Church of God denomination
 - f. Individuals or groups who are not affiliated with either the Minnesota State Conference or the Church of God denomination
- 2. The camp is smoke free. Smoking in buildings or on camp property is prohibited.
- 3. Use of alcohol or drugs on camp property is prohibited.
- 4. Use of fireworks on camp property is prohibited.
- 5. Use of firearms or hunting on camp property is prohibited.
- 6. Use of a water slide on camp property is prohibited.
- 7. Pets are not allowed on camp property without prior approval.
- 8. Only burn wood in the campfire ring. Trash cans are provided for the disposal of plastic and glass bottles, cans and other refuse.
- 9. Extinguish all campfires before leaving the campfire ring.
- 10. Do not clean fish in any of the buildings. Fish remains are to be wrapped in paper and disposed of in outdoor trash cans.
- 11. If you move beds, please return them to their original positions.
- 12. Make sure all windows and doors are closed and the lights are off before leaving.
- 13. A dishwashing system has been installed for your use. If you have questions about its use, please contact the caretaker. The State Department of Health does not allow drying the dishes with towels. Items washed are to be air dried.
- 14. The speed limit on the gravel road leading to the island is 15 MPH. Safety and dust control will help us maintain good relations with our neighbors.
- 15. Please be as quiet as possible after 10:30 PM.
